Dear Grade 3 Families,
In Language Arts, we have been talking about nouns (a person, place or thing), adjectives (describing words), \& Verbs (action words). This last week was Read in Week. We participated in Reading with our buddy class, Mrs. Mark's grade 6's \& we had an author visit from Mike Boldt. We also completed an "I am thankful" writing.

In Readers Workshop we have changed gears and are focusing on understanding what we've read. We talked about the importance of understanding what we read, and how good readers do comprehension checks by asking themselves questions (who is in this part, and what just happened) after they've read a chapter or a short book. They were then encouraged to write their responses on post-it notes. If they're unsure or unable to answer those questions, students are encouraged to go back and reread before continuing.

In Science, we have moved into talking about how rocks weather (break down) into soil. We will also talk about how soil erodes (moves from one place to another).

In Social, we will be introducing our textbook. It talks about Peru, Tunisia, Ukraine and India through the eyes of a fictional child who lives in each of these countries. We will be talking about how communities in these countries "work together" and how the governments run. This will be a great lead up to the Federal election coming up on Oct. $21^{\text {st }}$.

A Study Guide will be coming home for our Numbers to 1000 math test. We are hoping to have this test Thursday October $17^{\text {th }}$.
