Dear Grade 3 Families,

In **Language Arts**, we have been working on our 'best part of me' paragraphs and we continued to work on some more descriptive writing. Once we finished our drafts, we went back through our writing and revised it by adding more descriptive language to make it more exciting. This activity helped us as we did some revising on our 'best part of me' paragraph, by looking at how we can expand our thoughts and make our writing more interesting.

In **Readers Workshop** we continue to work on making sure we are understanding what we are reading. At the beginning of the week we discussed how avid readers retell big parts of the book that they've previously read. This means thinking of the main events, rather than focusing on less important details. We also spent some time sharing what we've read with our reading partners.

In **Science**, we have wrapped up rocks and minerals and we have moved into our hearing and sound unit. We talked about the different sounds we can hear around us in different spaces and we did some experiments with vibrating rulers at different lengths and the sounds that a variety of sizes of tuning forks make. We learned the longer the ruler the lower the sound and the larger tuning fork also made a lower sound.

In **Social**, we are talking about working together and what that looks like in different countries. We discussed what the qualities of a good leader are and we learned about how communities in Peru, Tunisia, Ukraine and India work together.
