This week: In **Language Arts**, we have gone over how to address an envelope and our Santa letters have been sent in the mail. We anxiously await a reply from Santa. We continue to work on reading comprehension strategies and our weekly word work to go along with our spelling words. We created "A Minion Reasons Why We Love Winter/Christmas" bulletin board to decorate our classroom for December and we have also written about what we think it would be like to live in a snow globe.
