Dear Grade 3 Families,
In Language Arts, we created an animal $A B C$ book. We used a thesaurus to help us use stronger verbs to describe these animals. We also did some inferring, by using text clues to help us better understand the texts we are reading. We also continued reading groups

In Math, we have been practicing adding and subtracting 2- and 3-digit numbers. We also practiced our problem-solving steps to help prepare for our test on Thursday.

In Science, we continue to do experiments related to our "Testing Materials and Designs. We continue to talk about what makes a "fair test" and make predictions in each experiment we do. We have started a "Nail" test to see if an uncoated nail, a painted nail or a galvanized nail will rust in the same way. We will keep them in water for 2 weeks and check in every couple of days. We also talked about the stability of containers and found out that tall containers with a narrow base are not as stable as short ones with a wide base. We are starting to collect materials for our building unit. Please send any recycled materials that can be used for building. For example: egg cartons, plastic containers/bottles, paper tubes, broken down boxes, etc.).

In Social, we are still talking about services people need to have a good quality of life. This week we looked at services in India. Then we chose a country to go back into the book and research the services that are available and made a web.
